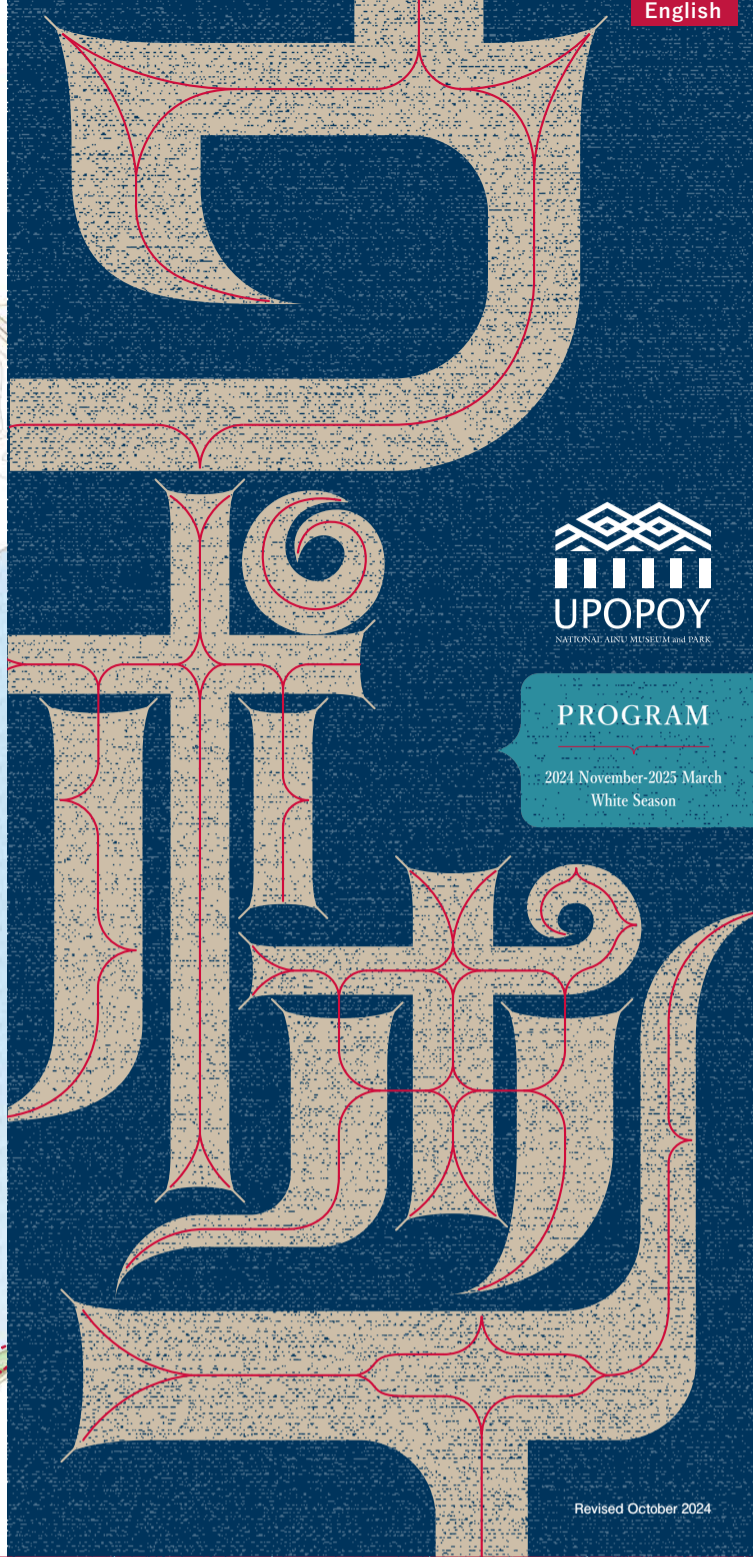

Length: Around 60 minutes

The exhibits reflect the Ainu people's perspective, centering on six concepts that all start with "our". Watch the theater program for an overview of Ainu culture.

Enjoy a range of traditional songs, dances and musical performances in a production that incorporates footage of Hokkaido's beautiful landscapes.

Learn about Ainu culture through various experiences, including cultural programs, paper theater shows and Ainu language bingo.
